



NEW!! 2017-18 Huron Student Travel Awards in British History

The Huron History Department is pleased to invite applications for 2017-18 Huron Student Travel Awards in British History, supported by the W. Galen Weston Fund for British History at Huron.

The department will fund research-based travel (up to \$2500) in pursuit of Huron course-based or thesis research in British and British colonial histories. Students may perform archival research, or consult documents or works unavailable in the region. Relevant nearby collections include the McMaster University Library, the Thomas Fisher Rare Books Collection, University of Toronto Library and Special Collections, the National Archives in Ottawa and the Yale Centre for British Art. Applications for research at more distant repositories will also be considered.

The awards may only be used to cover travel expenses (train, plane, bus or other) and accommodation expenses (accommodation and meals). Other travel- related expenses will not be reimbursed.

Eligibility:

Student travel award applicants must be currently enrolled in a History program at Huron.

Additional Notes:

Successful applicants will present their research findings at the Centre for Undergraduate Research Learning showcase in April, 2018, and are required to acknowledge the Huron Student Travel Award in British History, supported by the W. Galen Weston Fund in British History at Huron in any publications or other work supported by the award.

To apply, send a one-page letter that includes the following information:

- Year and program of study in History at Huron
- Brief description of proposed research, noting the materials to be consulted, their centrality to the research program, and the place of the research in the your course of study.
- A proposed budget (using the form provided.)
