Job Overview

The successful candidate will join the SSHRC-funded project, *Finding Christ Church: Social Justice in History, Memory, and Contemporary Practice, 1819-2019*, a collaboration among Huron's Community History Centre, the Centre for Public Theology at Huron, and the people of Christ Church, Chatham.

Duties will include:

- archival research
- building an accessible digital archive of research material (training provided)
- liaising with the local community
- assisting with the organizing of public events, including a "Living Library" event on June 1, and planning the project conference
- updating the project's social media accounts
- miscellaneous duties as required
