

# Is Dresden To Salute Human Rights?

OTTAWA — Prime Minister St. Laurent said today in the commons that he would consider the idea setting apart a "United Nations Human Rights Day."

He was answering Alistair Stewart (CCF—Winnipeg North) who later asked, in the event the decision is in the affirmative, "Will the town of Dresden, Ont., be informed?"

Mr. St. Laurent said if the suggestion is carried out the public will be informed in the usual way.

(Dresden, a town in Kent county, voted 517 to 108 Monday against a proposed bylaw which would have compelled restaurants to serve negroes. Nearly 20 per cent of Dresden's population of 2,000 are negroes.)
