

In what was described as a "comparatively light" vote, Dresden voters Monday turned down proposals for licensing town restaurants, and the installation of parking meters, and approved the town Police Commission, and the proposal for a beer and liquor store here.

The vote on the question in the four-way referendum:

Do you approve of Control of our police by our present Police Commission system? Yes: 409; No: 214.

Do you approve of parking meters being installed in the business-section of the Town? Yes: 207; No: 214.

Do you approve of a liquor store and beer warehouse being established in Dresden? Yes: 415; No: 240.

Do you approve of the Council passing a by-law licensing restaurants in Dresden and restraining the owners from refusing service, regardless of race, color or creed? Yes: 108 No: 517.

In all, an estimated 650 cast ballots in the referendum. Some, however, did not vote on all four questions.
